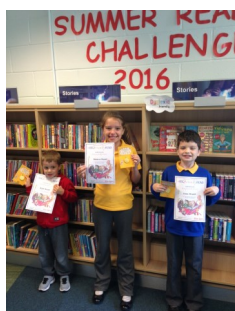
### Welcome to.....Bun Friday!
